Spinal corsets and abdominal supports are designed to support the muscular and bony structures of the spine. Highly effective in the non-operative treatment of back pain by preventing unnecessary movements that may further damage the back. Corsets provide additional muscular support which helps to align the spine and strengthen back muscles. Wearing a corset helps to minimise discomfort and acts as a reminder to avoid excessive low back motion and encourage proper body mechanics, such as good posture.

Our primary corset designs include Abdominal Supports and Lumbosacral Corsets both manufactured from superior fabrics and stiffened with flexible bones or rigid steels. Elastic panels and gussets provide comfort and flexibility and many additional high specification features are included as standard.



Abdominal support corset to relieve the strain on joints, ligaments and muscles caused by a pendulous abdomen or hernia and may also be used postoperatively as a binder for surgical dressings in the recovery process.

Lumbosacral corset to support the muscles of the lower back and immobilise and stabilise the spine following injury or surgery, until muscle strength can perform the job independently and your back pain decreases. Lumbosacral corsets may restrict some activities, however, the corset will aid healing and may help prevent further injury.
